#### Friends in Christ.





I did something this week that I had thought about for years; I got a tattoo. I knew that if I got one it would be on the back of my right hand so that people would see it when I gave them communion or when I shook their hands. I had always imagined that I would get a small cross, but I decided to get a semicolon instead. In one sense, this is an ironic choice; the semicolon is my least-favorite mark of punctuation. It seems wishywashy. Besides, most people use it improperly. On the other hand (pun very much intended), the semicolon has taken on a meaning that is very near to my heart.

I'm sure that there are multiple stories on how this happened, but I was directed to Project Semicolon by a former student who had a semicolon tattooed on her wrist. Their website states:

In April 2013, Amy Bleuel took to social media with an idea. Anyone who had ever struggled with a mental illness would draw a semicolon on their wrist and post a photo. A semicolon symbolized that a sentence wasn't over yet, and neither was their life.

The semicolon is a reminder to get help -- to fight through our struggles instead of giving up. This strange combination of a comma and a period (which we should all call by its British name -- a full stop) shows others that we have persevered, that there is hope, and that those who see it and respond to it are not alone.

I have been overwhelmed by the support that so many of you have given me in person and through phone calls, texts, and notes. You may have noticed that I am not great at taking you up on your offers to talk about it. That is part of the process that I am still learning. It is hard to know how to talk about mental health, even when you know that people are genuinely concerned and willing to listen. Also, how I feel varies widely depending on the situation. It is difficult to find the balance between "I'm fine" and pulling up a couch and unloading on someone.

My hope is that by sharing my struggles and working through them in a semi-public way, I can empower others to share. This experience should also be invaluable as I work with others who struggle with mental health.

- Request from Pastor Kevin Rosendahl on behalf of Grace Christian Outreach Ministries for donations for them to purchase a newer ministry van.
- Grace Christian Outreach Ministries-a donation of \$2,000 will be given out of the Investment Committee Funds. (Judi/Jeff) & council approved.
- Quote to seal coat asphalt was received from Jeremy Osteraas for \$4,410. Possibly do in the near future.
- Adapter/phone sound system equipment was purchased for the church. Funds were used from a donation from Steve and Terri Myhre (Tera's G. parents) and the technology fund.
