Friends in Christ.

I spoke briefly and incorrectly about the history of infant baptism recently. The following is based on some internet research and some of my own thoughts. It is not meant to be a complete, scholarly treatment, but an introduction to the topic. The articles that I read agreed that there is no explicit endorsement of or condemnation of the practice of infant baptism. There is evidence that infants were being baptized as early as the first century and that it had become common practice by the third century. By the time of the Protestant Reformation, infant baptism was the norm.

We cannot be sure of what, exactly, was meant when the apostles baptized "whole households." All of the baptisms recorded in scripture are of adult converts or are unclear about whether children were included. Without explicit Biblical direction, experts turn to church history and how different faith traditions understand baptism. Even if we agree that baptism is a rite of initiation into the church, there are multiple ways of understanding what that means. Can parents who are themselves baptized members of the church speak for their children, bringing them into the church as well, or is baptism reserved for those who can "credibly and consciously profess their belief in Christ?" Either way, it can be said that the church and family work toward the goal of bringing up the child so that they reach that point.

Another factor in the debate is the understanding of sin and redemption. Supporters of infant baptism often use the idea of original sin -- the sinfulness that has been pervasive in humanity ever since Adam and Eve tasted the apple -- and the need for even infants to be cleansed. On the other hand, there is historical evidence that some people put off baptism as long as possible so that they could continue to sin. My understanding is that neither side in this debate currently believes that baptism is the "end of the road" as far as our relationship with God. Yes, our sins are forgiven, but we will continue to be in need of forgiveness as we are bound to continue to sin.

Beyond a history lesson, there are some things that I would like to share as we rapidly move closer to Advent. As a matter of fact, we are going to hurry Advent along this year. Because Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday, we will not have a morning worship that day. That means that we lose the fourth Sunday of Advent. In order to avoid that, we will begin observing Advent a week early this year. Several of the confirmands, a number of adult volunteers and I "retreated" to the Abbey of the Hills over MEA weekend. We enjoyed the perfect fall weather, the beauty of the Abbey and grounds, and our time together. Thank you to the churches for supporting our youth in this way. Speaking of youth, it is wonderful that groups at both churches stepped up to host a "Sunday Fun Day" on Halloween weekend. We will again be worshiping with Trinity of Montevideo and Salem on Thanksgiving Eve. It is encouraging to watch this relationship grow as we establish some new traditions.

Baxter WELCA Meeting Minutes - October 22, 2023

Present: Lynette Norman, Caroline Nordaune, Margaret Kruger, Bernice Moseng, Alissa Dyshaw, Carla Johnson, Gayle Staab, Diane Olson & Sara Croymans

President Carla Johnson called the meeting to order following the 9:00 a.m. church service.

M/S/P to accept the minutes of the July 30, 2023, meeting were approved (Sara/Bernice) with corrections that the church supper dues remained \$10 rather than the approved \$5 change and that the old church dishes were not sold at the turkey supper as discussed, but were available for taking with a donation.

M/S/P to approve the Treasurer's Report (Alissa/Margaret). It was noted on the Turkey Supper financial report that three Thrivent cards were used to offset expenses. We had a profit of \$3,890.38. A pork feed was held on the same date that provided competition for our dinner.

- The new 2024 budget was provided. **M/S/P** to replace Heifer International donation with LSS MN Cherish All Children (Carolyn/Lynette) and M/S/P to replace Current for Curran with Katie's Fund (Bernice/Alissa).
- A thank you potluck meal for Dick Olson, retired janitor, was discussed, possibly scheduled for the second weekend of November. It was assumed the Council would provide a cake, so the potluck would be advertised that desserts are covered.
- Electrical candles for the altar were discussed, given the Council wants to replace the wax candles. Carla has been searching for alternatives. WELCA suggests that perhaps the cost of new candles be covered by memorial funds.
- Carpet cleaning was discussed, including what we want to clean (basement, entry-level, sanctuary, stairs).
 Carla was going to secure a quote, possibly from Mike Torgerson or Sun Bright. There was also discussion about how old the carpet is and if replacing the carpet would be an option. There was also discussion on what costs WELCA should cover and what the Church should cover.
- A potential kitchen remodel was discussed. No plans have been received from the individual identified at the

April meeting. Carla will contact Kayla at Builder's First Source. There was a discussion on what we want to be done in the kitchen – perhaps a stainless-steel countertop on the middle counter, do something with the walls, leave the cabinets, update electrical, etc.

- WELCA will provide sweet treats after the Sunday School Christmas Program on December 10.
- A thank you note was received from Carol & Scott Brunner from Wisconsin who had relatives who belonged to Baxter after visiting the church.

- Thanksgiving Service Wed., Nov. 22 -Service at Trinity in Monte and there are also services at Dawson churches as options.
- Joint Council in November -Date is set for Nov. 15th at Saron at 8:00 -Baxter will meet at 7:00 before joint meeting
- Estate of Pastor Robert Esse -OSL Church of Baxter was named as a beneficiary in the estate of Pastor Esse. The amount is \$1,000 which will be distributed in approximately 6 months.
- The Synod Assembly increased the rates for both lay and ordained pulpit supply. The new rate is \$175 plus IRS mileage for one service.
- December 24th services One in the morning and the Christmas Eve Service in the evening? -Decided on having only the Christmas Eve service in the evening.
- Evergreen tree needs to be removed near the church.
 Decision was made to go ahead and have cut down. Decision will have to be made if church or cemetery will pay for it.
