Joint Ministry Board Minutes

Joint Ministry Board Minutes

Saron Lutheran & Our Savior's Lutheran Church of Baxter October 26, 2023 @ 7:00 PM Church Office in Montevideo

Members present: Lori Formo, Michelle May, Dustin Johnson, Judi Eggert. Members Absent: Lyndsae Dack, David Lipps, Heidi Lipps. Also present: Pastor Matt Danielson

The Committee started with a brief discussion about music at Saron and how far in advance the music selections are determined in order to incorporate some contemporary music into the service. Pastor Matt indicated we need to follow up with Pam as to when those selections are made.

The Committee discussed the upcoming Advent season and Pastor Matt indicated the Advent readings and hymns needed to be determined a few weeks ago because of the other scheduled activities such as the children's Christmas programs. However, the two churches may be holding their Christmas programs on different weekends, likely December 10th and 17th, but to be confirmed with Pam. Therefore, the opposite weekend of the Christmas program for each Church could have something special or different. The Committee discussed ideas for this service including:

- Are there different stories to be told around the traditional Christmas story?
- Can we compare different versions of the story?
- How was the story put together considering no one had all the pieces?
- Focus on one side of the story from the Shepherd's point of view or the three wise men.

Pastor Matt liked the idea about the Shepherd's perspective of the Christmas Story and will consider incorporating this into one of the services in December.

The Committee discussed other ideas to build fellowship and engage members including:

- Family retreat to Green Lake
- How to create more impact for people?
- Kids activities during worship

- Some enjoy taking notes or a more interactive approach to learn
- Utilizing different formats such as sitting at tables instead of pews to create more interaction
- Incorporating table activities in the basement may work well during Lent
- Potlucks on Communion Sundays
- Restart the Coffee & Cookies before and after services.
 It was requested that Pastor Matt ask Pam to recreate the sign-up sheets.

The group discussed the timing and responsibility of decorating the churches for Christmas. The group agreed that decorating should occur after service on November 19th due to the Advent services starting on November 26th. It is helpful for members to participate in the decorating and to have a couple of designated individuals to coordinate the volunteers.

Pastor Matt updated the Committee about Thanksgiving Eve services which will be held at Trinity Lutheran Church in Montevideo.

The Committee then brought up other topics for discussion related to regular services. The Committee discussed singing during Communion which could be done with playing music with lyrics and familiar hymns that are easy to sing along too and attendees can easily stop and rejoin during the Communion.

The Committee reviewed times we sit versus stand and possibly trying variations of this during the service.

The Committee and Pastor Matt acknowledged the valuable work of Pam Schultz in keeping everything organized and completing the various duties of her position, as well as incorporating changes into the bulletin and service at the request of the Committee.

The next meeting of the Ministry Committee will be January 11, 2024 at 7:00 pm in the Church Office. The back-up date will be January 18th in the event of inclement weather. The Committee will discuss feedback from the Advent season, as well as upcoming ideas for the Lenten period which begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was concluded with a prayer.

M/S/C (Inez/Deb) to accept the Treasurer's Report as printed.

OLD BUSINESS:

• Thermostat Updates -Installed a week ago. Will schedule training with Kevin Augeson & Kristen will need to be trained. \$675 to install.

• Financial Update – status -Right now we have loans from Investment fund for \$10,000 and \$10,000 from bank. Should put in newsletter to make everyone aware. We need additional money for other bills at the end of the year also.

-We have another \$5,000 available from the bank if needed.

• Dick Olson Retirement Celebration-Sun., Dec. 3rd -Council to provide cake/food. Inez will bring lemonade and Deb will bring cookies. Anyone can bring other sweets.

• Candles on the altar-ordered 11/14/23-box of 250/same price as box of 100. Pam ordered us candles to get us by for 3 months until we can find other candles. -Need to find alternate option-electric

-Carla J. is also reviewing options

• Confirmation Retreat Bill-Abby of the Hills -Will pay through Sunday school account which is \$334.73 total

• Signs in front of church -move out 20 feet from all concrete for ease of snow removal in the winter.

• Sidewalk project - if we spend more than \$8,000 we will need congregation to approve. Will bring up at the annual meeting. This will probably be done in the spring.

• Dead evergreen tree was taken down by Jeff Nyheim which also had broken limbs.

NEW BUSINESS:

• GCOM (Grace Christian Outreach Ministry)-Dec./Jan. donation needs-Hats/Mittens/Gloves

• 2024 Budget **M/C/S** (Jeremy/Loren) to approve projected budget for 2024. Includes a 7% synod recommended pay raise for Matt and Pam.

• Nominating Committee

-Appoint 2 outgoing council members to serve with Berta Bjerkeset. Brenda Berends & Cody Dyshaw are willing to serve with Berta.

Diane went over the treasurer's report. After a few questions, which were answered, this report was approved.

The office account report was also approved as presented. **OLD BUSINESS:**

• We discussed the fundraising project for the remodeling project. We discussed the meat raffle. Most of the remodeling project has been taken care of. Some of the money we got for the storm damage was used for this project.

• Izzy has basically finished the storm damage issues. He still has a few things to finish. Because we are short of money to pay for the storm damage, we passed a motion to take money from the Parsonage savings account and pay Izzy. This motion was passed unanimously. However, it means we will need more money for future unknown projects.

• The elevator was discussed. It seems to be working fine now but phone service needs to be installed in the elevator. Steve J. is going to complete this project.

• We discussed mileage for the Pastor. It will be further discussed with both councils. This is about mileage for nonmembers of our congregations when Pastor Matt helps out with weddings, funerals, etc. Our councils think this kind of ministry is wonderful. We encourage Matt to continue this ministry. We decided to start with 100 miles per month and re-evaluate at a later date.

• Water testing has been done. Some issues were found but have been corrected.

Pastor Esse passed away and left the church \$1,000.

• We decided to give Heritage Hill \$100 for use of their facility.

• The Synod came out with some new guidelines for pulpit supply.

• Stan K. and Steve R. will serve on the nominating committee with Jaden for the annual meeting.

• A discussion was held on the auditing committee. We need one new member.

• The budget was discussed. We voted unanimously to approve the Pastor's salary to go with the guidelines from the synod. Pam also got a raise in pay.

• Work groups were discussed. We need to decide on group leaders for 2024.
