I hope that many of you will join me in making this a habit in the new year.

# How Jesus taught his disciples to pray

- -- Find a time and place to pray.
- -- Remind yourself that God, the creator of everything, the most powerful force in the universe, <u>loves</u> you, <u>listens</u> to you and wants <u>the best</u> for you.
- -- Ask God to help you to think like God thinks.
- -- Thank God for all of the small blessings that surround us and for the giant blessing of being loved.
- -- Ask for forgiveness for your mistakes and incidences of poor judgment. Pray for the strength to do better.

- \*\*\* **Especially** ask God to help you to forgive others so that you can be an example of God's love in the world.
- -- Ask God to take away all of the stuff that keeps you from being the person you are meant to be.
- -- Remember that all you are and all you have is God's
- -- Repeat regularly

#### Start 2024 HEALTHY!

The new year is a great time for a fresh start on being a HEALTHIER you! Did you know that as little as 100 extra

calories a day can cause weight gain? Did you know that you can burn approximately 100 calories on a 30-minute walk? When I think about being healthy, I like to think of it as a check and balance system. I make sure that I am putting healthy foods into my body every day (fruits, veggies, lean meats, water) and I make sure that I raise my heart rate every day (intentional exercise or just working around the house!). Here are some tips to help you make good choices to be HEALTHY in 2024!

- Avoid the "Great White Hazards" which are the highly refined foods such as white flour products, white rice, white potatoes, and sugar/sweets. These foods commonly elevate blood sugar and promote fat storage. The elevation in blood sugar also causes a sudden drop which signals the "appetite command center" to eat more.
- 2. Fill up on fiber because it quiets the appetite and feeds the "good" bacteria in the gut. Good sources of fiber are beans, whole fruit, veggies, and whole grains.
- Limit your intake of fructose. Fructose is sugar found in sweet foods and beverages, desserts and most cereals. Processed foods are often high in fructose so limit foods such as fat free dressings, flavored yogurt, etc.
- Get your protein every day! Protein provides appetite control and helps decrease loss of muscle mass. Good choices include fish, poultry, peanut/nut butter, seeds, low fat dairy, eggs, and beans.
- 5. Get your beauty sleep! Shoot for 7-8 hours of sleep every night. Research shows that a lack of sleep can cause you to eat more in turn causing weight gain.
- 6. Exercise to help burn calories and help control your appetite. Make it a goal to get some form of exercise in every day, like walking, swimming, riding bike, etc.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**


