


Friends in Christ,

In this newsletter you will find a schedule for the entire summer. Both councils have agreed to a summer schedule with 9 am worship at Saron or Baxter on alternating Wednesdays and 7 pm worship on Wednesdays. The Sunday morning services will be traditional communion services held in the sanctuary. The Wednesday services will be more along the lines of the Lenten Wednesday services in that they will be focused on a single text and will be held in the church basements. There are plans at Baxter for some fireside gatherings, so keep your eyes open for those. There will also likely be at least one Wednesday service at Heritage Hill during the summer. My plan is to cover the book of Daniel on Wednesdays this summer.

Joint Ministry Board Minutes

Saron Lutheran & Our Savior's Lutheran Church of Baxter April 18, 2024 @ 7:00 PM

Pastor Matt opened the meeting asking for feedback on the Wednesday night Lenten Supper services. The group discussed the strong attendance (50+ each night) which included a wide range of ages. People were more engaged than regular service and the food helped. Pastor Matt expressed his thanks to those who helped with the meals.

The first service seemed to have good discussion at the small tables, but not in the larger group. The Committee discussed the dynamics how people say they know nothing in group-settings, but then open up and get comfortable. How do we extend that comfort to the larger group discussion? The Committee discussed the attendance of the confirmation kids and how their participation at separate tables was good. It helped other members of the church to get to know them.

Pastor Matt explained the changes of the Holy Week service and asked for feedback. Members commented they liked the services because if you missed a day, then you still got the full service. There was discussion on pieces that were not done such as stripping the alter. Pastor Matt talked about doing that differently next time to get more effect on why we are doing it. Perhaps doing less may help to highlight the transition from before the alter is stripped to after.

The Baxter members talked about being more intentional around meals and the Saron members commented on the lack of their own planning and coordination for the Easter Sunday Meal. How is it decided who plans the meals. The Committee talked about planning ahead better and discussing it early enough for future Easters. At times, someone just needs to be asked to coordinate the Easter breakfast. The Worship Committee could help plan ahead and coordinate that, but it should also include coordination with Church councils, confirmation kids and others.

Pastor Matt talked about the upcoming Confirmation and how he had provided the kids with a short assessment about what was discussed during the confirmation classes to see what the kids learned and retained. Pastor Matt explained the process of earning points and how the kids ended the Confirmation sessions with a wide range of points. The Committee talked about the challenge of making the teachings stick and helping the kids understand the fundamentals.

Next, the Committee talked about summer services which will be held on Wednesday and Sunday every other week which will be clearly communicated and documented on the church's website, bulletins, newsletter, etc. Communion will be done on Sundays. There will be no altar gild or organists on Wednesdays. At least one Wednesday service will be held at Heritage Hill for each Saron and Baxter, as well as possibly an outside service for Baxter. Wednesday service can provide flexibility for location, and the communication must be flexible to tell people about locations or how to plan for the type of service (i.e. bring lawn chairs, outside attire, etc.) The Committee talked about how the style of church may impact who attends.

Sunday service may focus on the more traditional gospel and Pastor Matt talked about the Book of Daniel for summer services. The Book of Daniel contains 12 Chapters which would fit nicely into the summer schedule. The Wednesday service will be a lead in to Sunday. The Memorial Day week service for Baxter will be at Heritage Hill. The group talked about possibly a Saron service at Heritage Hill in July. Typically, a meal is served at Heritage Hill and meals can also be done on an ad hoc basis.

The Senior Recognition will be on Mother's Day Sunday. And the group thought it would be good to have the Vacation Bible School kids sing their songs at a Wednesday night service the week of or after Vacation Bible School. Communication with those responsible for VBS will need to occur for coordination.

The Committee discussed ideas on how to communicate with the members. Due to rising postal rates and declining membership, the mailed newsletter may be too costly. The group talked about examples from other churches who email the Newsletter or have it printed and provided at Church. The group talked about other mediums too including Facebook, email, radio, and newspaper.

The Worship Committee will meet again on August 15th at 7:00 pm at the Church Office.

Baxter Council Minutes

Baxter Council Minutes - April 10, 2024

The Church Council meeting was called to order by President Jeff Johnson on April 10, 2024, by President Jeff Johnson.

Council members present: Larry Borstad, Inez Bjerkeset, Dave Croymans, Richard Erickson, Jeff Johnson, Jeremy Enevoldsen, Mike Hoime, Taylor Strand, Terry Litke, Judi Eggert

M/S/C (Jeremy/Terry) to accept the Pastor's report as printed.

M/S/C (Larry/Mike) to accept the minutes of the March 13, 2024, Secretary's Report as printed.

M/S/C (Dick/Terry to accept the Treasurer's Report as printed.

M/S/C (Judi/Inez) to accept the Office Account Report as printed.

Old Business:

- The painting project in the entryway and adjacent areas was completed for \$8,409.89.
- Lights in the entryway were replaced for \$346.75 with installation labor of \$495.00. M/S/C (Larry/Dick) to pay this out of the repairs and improvements fund.
- It is anticipated that the carpet replacement will begin the week of April 15.
- The six windows in the entryway and chapel will be installed at approximately the same time.
- The council expressed gratitude for Gary and Brenda Strand's efforts to fix the roof vents to prevent leaking.
- Sidewalks will be replaced by Larsons. No timeline was noted.
- Jeremey secured a bid of \$7,000 for a furnace heat. The council decided to table a decision until the landscaping was completed.
- M/S/C (Terry/Judi) to accept a bid of \$2,000 from MAAC to re-landscape a problem area at the back of the church near the air conditioner to prevent water issues. Tyler Strand will contact Kevin Augeson to get a price to disconnect and reconnect the air conditioning while the work is being done.

- French Glass will be replacing weather stripping on the church entry doors.
- Thank you, Loren, for addressing the issues with the wireless microphone, which is now working.
- Discussion on ideas for Memorial was tabled.
- The Council requests that Pam order more candles for the altar. A search for an electric candelabra has been unsuccessful, although single ones are available.
- The old member mailbox will be replaced. Anyone who wants the old one should notify Jeff Johnson.

New Business:

- The Council was informed of a non-member wedding on June 15 (Fox/Garcia). Cost is based on the Church policy of \$200 for the church and \$50 for the custodian.
- The Joint Service on Wednesday, May 22 will be held at Heritage Hill @ 6:00 pm with a potluck to follow. The Baxter Council is responsible for paper products and beverages. Judy and Pastor Matt volunteered.
- Summer Services: For the summer Wednesday services there is no need for an organist or alter guild. The Baxter/Saron 2024 Summer Worship Schedule will be printed in the newsletter and posted at the church. Note: Communion will only be offered at the Sunday services.
- M/S/C (Judi/Jeremy) to publish only one church newsletter for the summer (June/July/August)
- Confirmation information was shared. Reese Maher will be confirmed on April 28. The first-year students are Reagan Bossert and Levi Enevoldsen. Beginning Confirmation next year will be Lola Stone, London Strand, and Kane McCarty.
- Ditch clean-up was scheduled for April 21 following the church service.
- M/S/C (Dick/Inez) to move the management duties of our Edward Jones account to Shelly Bedner.

The next Council meeting will be on Wednesday, May 8 at 7:00 pm.

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer and adjourned at 9:45 pm.
